From the Pastor's Study

Greetings from Pastor Sarah!

Matthew 25:34-35, 37-38a, 40, "Then the king will say to those at his right hand, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world, for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me...Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when was it that we saw you hungry and gave you food or thirsty and gave you something to drink? And when was it that we saw you a stranger and welcomed you...?' And the king will answer them, 'Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did it to me."

YOU were the sheep in this parable. YOU fed the hungry. YOU gave drink to the thirsty. YOU welcomed the stranger, sat with them, ate with them, listened to them, gave them dignity. YOU did this, not just for the 1000+ people that we fed on September 8th in our Attack on Butte Hunger, but you did this for Jesus. "Just as you did it to one of the least of these...you did it to me."

I am so proud to be a part of these congregations and the good work that we are allowing the Holy Spirit to do through us, and the Attack on Butte Hunger was an example of just that. We took on a challenge, a big challenge, and we concluded that hunger is unacceptable, that every person, no matter their background or story, deserves dignity, deserves food, deserves help when help is needed.

On September 8th, we fed over a thousand people. We connected people with resources from the Butte Rescue Mission, WIC, SNAP, Butte 4 C's, and the Butte Emergency Food Bank, so that they will hopefully be less food insecure going forward. We also donated 432 pounds of food and \$1,465 to the Butte Emergency Food Bank! But beyond that, we partnered with 8 churches beyond our Copper City Parish, and we showed the Butte community that the Gospel isn't just talk, that we take our call from God seriously, seriously enough to feed our community, to account for the needs that we see, and to allow God to work through us to do good in our community.

THANK YOU ALL for everything you did to make this project a success! I can't wait to do it again next

year!!

4) Approval of the Minutes: August 13, 2024

• It was motioned, seconded, and carried (MSC) to approve the Council Meeting Minutes for August 13th, 2024.

5) Pastor's Report

• Pastor Sarah provided a list of her monthly activities which included:

Check-in Phone Calls: 65 Community Outreach: 28 Home Communion Visits: 15 (10 Gold Hill; 5 Gloria Dei) Counseling Sessions: 4 Funeral Services: 2 Nursing Home Services: 0

Average Weekly Hours: 44.25

• Pastor Sarah requested time off from October 1st through October 7th.

6) Treasurer's Report

- Danette reported that she was still working on the August financial reports and would provide them as soon as they were complete.
- Danette gave an update on God's Work Our Hands "attack on hunger" event; the total expenses for Gold Hill was \$2,110 and donations received during the event was \$2,175.

7) President's Report

• David provided an update on remediation activities. Remedial activities are continuing to progress and work is complete to the Parsonage. A church member agreed to pay for additional curbing to be replaced along the Parsonage. The lava rock will not be reinstalled and will instead be included as an item in the Harvest Auction. 8) Administrative Director's Report

- David provided the Administrative Director's Report on Ty's behalf:
 - o The lease agreement with the Pre-School has been signed.
 - o A short-term task force has been formed to review and revise the existing church constitution.

9) Worship Ministry

• Shelly reported the service at Stodden Park was a great success and had a higher attendance then last year.

10) Leadership Ministry

• Nothing to report.

11) Spiritual Growth Ministry

• Pat reported that Sunday School starts next Sunday (9/15).

12) Outreach Ministry

- Linda reported on recent Mission of the Month efforts, which included providing school supplies and \$50 gift cards to new teachers.
- The Council discussed purchasing a table at the Butte Rescue Mission Banquet on October 10th. Donations will be pursued to cover the \$500.00 cost.

13) Other Business:

- The Council discussed the God's Work Our Hands "attack on hunger" event and recommendations for improving the event in the future; takeaways from the event included:
 - o Approximately 1,000 people were fed with twothirds of those being the target audience.
 - o 432 pounds of food and \$1,400 raised for the Butte Emergency Food Bank.
 - o Multiple people signed up for support services.
 - o Potentially 3 new families are considering joining the church as a result of the event.
- It was noted that Lefse making is scheduled for October 24th through the 26th.
